Language Task	Description	Language skills	CLB level	Vyew Features
Looking for an apartment	Look through the rental advertisements, discuss possible variants with your roommate and agree on the best variant for you	reading (read ads) writing (take notes) listening and speaking (discuss options with a partner)	CLB 4+: learner gets the overall meaning; identifies type and purpose of the text; finds key information and specific details; compares simple information	upload images/upload webpage, drawing tools, sticky notes, comments, voice/video chat
Leave a voice message	Read a wedding invitation, record a voice message (accept or decline the invitation)	reading (read the invitation) speaking (leave a voice message)	CLB 4+: learner understands moderately complex public social messages; accepts or declines invitations; leaves short simple voice mail messages	upload images, voice comments



Making a shopping list	Watch and discuss video recipes, agree on the Thanksgiving dinner menu, and make a shopping list	listening (watch video recipes, listen to a partner) speaking (discuss, make suggestions) writing (make a shopping list) reading (read notes in the video)	CLB 5+: authentic speech (normal rate), not face-to-face (recorded)	Upload video, sticky notes, voice/video chat
Making appointments	Schedule your meetings for the upcoming month	speaking and listening (discuss a possible date) writing (take notes)	CLB 3+: learner understands specific details, asks and responds to simple questions	upload images, drawing tools, sticky notes, voice/video chat
Writing a cover letter	Read a job posting, brainstorm areas of expertise related to the position, write a cover letter	reading (read a posting) writing (make notes, write a cover letter)	CLB 7+: context of educational and work-related life experience	drawing tools, upload webpage, sticky notes
Space planning	Plan the layout of your room with your roommate	speaking and listening (discuss with a partner) writing (take notes)	CLB 3+: learner gives simple, common, routine instructions related to everyday activities.	upload images, drawing tools, VoIP, sticky notes, comments
Initiating small talk	Initiate small talk with a stranger in a given situation	speaking and listening	CLB 2+: learner opens a short conversation; participates in a short, casual conversation in non-demanding context	upload images, voice/video chat
Giving directions	Agree on a place where to meet at lunch and give directions	speaking and listening writing (taking notes)	CLB 3+: learner gives short simple directions, expresses movement and location	upload images, drawing tools, voice/video chat
