





- 1. Set clear expectations
- 2. Start flipping together
- 3. Flip one activity or the whole session
- 4. Repurpose & recycle
- 5. Use OAR or create own resources



How to Flip

- 6. Receptive (pre); productive (in)
- 7. Real-world productive task (pre)
- 8. Become a facilitator
- 9. Personal language learning environment
